



Job Description for Beerfest: Volunteers

Responsibilities as a Volunteer:

- Check in at the Volunteer Check in Station
- Hand out items (beer glasses/other promotional items as needed)
- Scan tickets using electronic scanning device and wristband attendees
- Pour beers from a tap (rare cases from a can)
- Minimal cleaning/disinfecting tabletops during the event
- Carry/transporting items from one location to another (by hand or handcart if necessary)
