### Orange County Ronald McDonald House

“There’s no place like home.” This statement rings especially true for those families who must come to Orange County area children’s hospitals to have their children receive treatment for cancer and other serious illnesses or injuries. Sometimes, their treatment lasts for days, weeks, months, and even years, creating a hardship for these families.

Over 28 years ago, a group of caring doctors, parents, and volunteers had a dream of building a Ronald McDonald House in Orange County so that parents could stay close to their hospitalized child. The Orange County Ronald McDonald House, located at 383 South Batavia Street in Orange, has 20 private guest rooms, all with private bathrooms, a large spacious kitchen and dining room, computers with high-speed internet access, complimentary laundry facilities, and much more. In 2016, we provided a refuge for nearly 2,500 people!

At the Orange County Ronald McDonald House, for only \$10.00 per night, families can enjoy all of the comforts of home, receive nutritious meals provided by volunteers, and obtain emotional support through contact with other families experiencing similar situations. No family is ever turned away if they cannot afford that small fee.

### Ronald McDonald House Family Rooms

Continued, selfless commitment on the part of thousands of volunteers and donors helped build two Ronald McDonald Family Rooms—one at CHOC Children’s in Orange and one at CHOC Children’s at Mission Hospital in Mission Viejo. The Ronald McDonald Family Rooms offer a comfortable respite within the hospital setting.

## Collect pop tabs to benefit the Orange County Ronald McDonald House and Ronald McDonald Family Rooms

The recycling of these pop tabs is one of our on-going fundraising programs that helps support our mission of providing comfortable housing and emotional support to families of critically ill and injured children being treated at Orange County hospitals.

### What is a Pop Tab?

A Pop Tab is the piece of metal that opens aluminum cans. Like the can, the pull-tab is recyclable and helps our environment while helping our families.

### Why Collect Pop Tabs?

- ♥ Clean
- ♥ Appeals to all ages
- ♥ Convenient
- ♥ Easy fundraising project  
(You can still recycle the can for its CRV value)

The amount of money received is determined by the weight of aluminum collected. All the collections add up to make a heartfelt impact for the Ronald McDonald House and Ronald McDonald Family Rooms. Money received is not credited toward any medical treatment. Cans can't be saved because we do not have the room to store them, but we encourage you to save cans, turn them in to a recycling center and send the check to the Orange County Ronald McDonald House.



### Pop Tab Trivia

Did you know...

- 1 Pop Tab is approximately 1 inch long
- 1,267 Pop Tabs make 1 pound
- 1 pound of aluminum can be sold for approximately 45¢ - 60¢ per pound

## Pop Tab Collection Containers

Pop Tabs can be collected in any type of container, or in our Pop Tab collection houses. Collection houses are available to individuals and organizations in limited quantities. We encourage you to create your own collection container(s) using non-glass items such as ice cream buckets, milk containers, coffee cans, cardboard boxes, or any other sturdy container.

- ♥ First 5 small houses (pint-sized and holds about 850 Pop Tabs) are free, and we charge 25¢ for each additional small house.
- ♥ First 2 large houses (holds about 15-20 pounds of Pop Tabs) are free, and we charge \$1.50 for each additional large house.

## HOW TO TURN IN YOUR POP TAB COLLECTION

**First Option:** You may drop off your Pop Tabs at the Orange County Ronald McDonald House any time of the day. Directions to the House can be found on our website at [www.rmhcsc.org/orangecounty](http://www.rmhcsc.org/orangecounty). Our recycling center picks up our Pop Tabs once a month. We receive a check for the tabs which is applied to our annual operating budget.

**Second Option:** You may take your Pop Tabs and cans directly to a recycling center near you.
