Camp Ronald McDonald for Good Times

Founded in 1982, Camp Ronald McDonald for Good Times is one of the nation's largest recreational camp programs for children with cancer and their families. Camp activities are specifically designed to meet the physical needs of campers, and to develop social and emotional competencies in youth who have lost much of their childhood to treatment and hospital stays. At the same time, camp programs connect children and parents with others who face the same day to day challenges and help families build a network of support.

Each year, Camp welcomes nearly **1,800 campers** to the serenity of our facility in the San Jacinto Mountains. Due to the devastating financial effects of cancer, **our programs are offered FREE of charge**. Thanks to over 400 volunteer staff of doctors, nurses, and specially trained counselors, Camp provides a medically safe and psychologically supportive environment for all of our special campers.



Camp Ronald McDonald for Good Times is a program of the Ronald McDonald House Charities of Southern California ("RMHCSC"). **Our mission is to provide comfort, care, and support to critically-ill children and their families.** We achieve this mission through six Ronald McDonald Houses, in-hospital Family Rooms, and Camp Ronald McDonald for Good Times. Each year RMHCSC reaches upwards of 70,000 families throughout Southern California.
