Volunteers and community members have contributed muchneeded pantry items, including instant oatmeal, tortillas, fresh fruit, deli items, single-serving bags of chips, cookies or nuts, granola bars, and individual fruit or pudding cups. Wish list donations continue to be dropped off at the House also – gift cards for grocery stores and Target, along with cleaning supplies being some of our most used items currently.

In April, our 9th Annual Walk for Kids had to transition from an in-person event to one held virtually. With the support of our event co-chairs, event committee, and the community rallying together through online fundraising, even though we could not be together in-person, more than \$160,000 was raised for our program. This would not have happened without your commitment and help – thank you!
